The Information Technology Standards Committee (ITSC), together with the Institute of Systems Science (ISS) and the Linux Users' Group (Singapore) (LUGS), see this as a timely move to organize the Training Workshop on the newly released Linux Standards Base (LSB) version 3.0 (released July 1, 2005).

LSB is a specification developed by the Free Standards Group, a non-profit organization dedicated to accelerating the use of free and open source software by developing and promoting standards. The Specifications and Release Notes can be found here.

Workshop Details

- Aim:** The workshop aims to equip participants with an understanding of the LSB version 3.0 compliance test program for runtime systems and applications. Compliance testing is a key component of LSB as it ensures the correct implementation of the specification.
- Brief Agenda:** Introduction to LSB version 3.0 specification
Tools for compliance testing
- Pre-requisites:** Prior experience with installing & using Linux will be useful. Preferably to familiarize themselves with LSB specification before they come for raining.
- Trainer:** Mats Wichmann is Linux Standards Architect with Intel Corporation and is current Chairman of the LSB Project. He is part of the Open Source Technology Center at Intel. He has been a developer with the LSB project since 2001, and was elected LSB Chairman in January 2004. Mats has been a UNIX and later Linux developer since 1980 and has also worked as a consultant, trainer, and courseware developer. He has past standards/ABI experience with the MIPS ABI Group where he worked as technical director and is an Austin Group and an IEEE Standards Association member. Mats is also the co-author of the book "Building Applications with the Linux Standard Base".

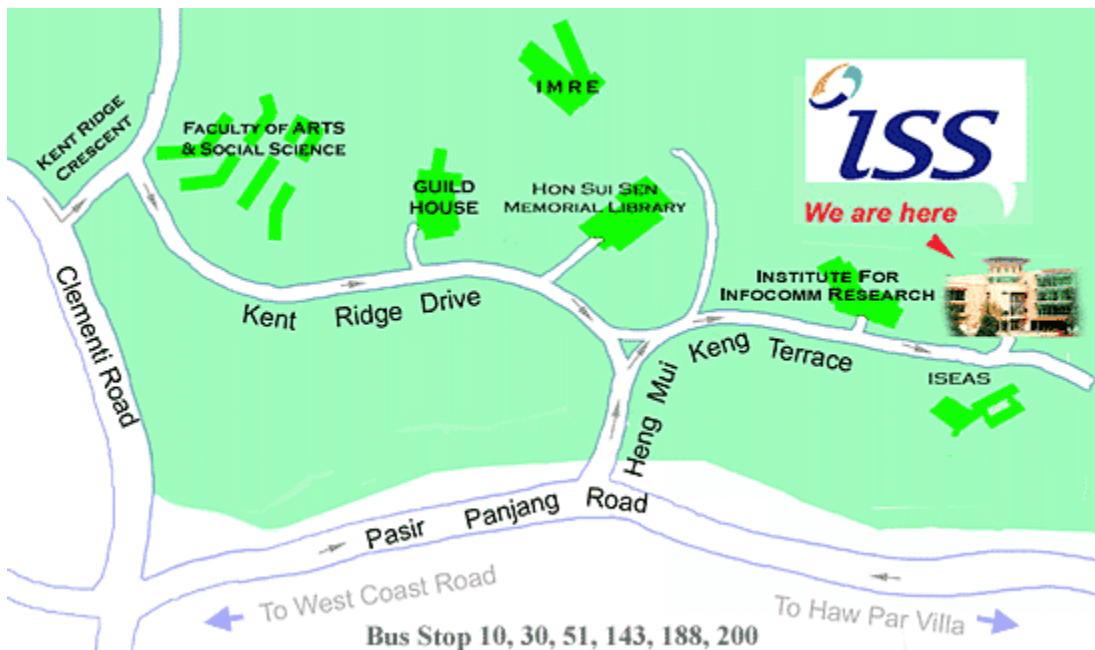
