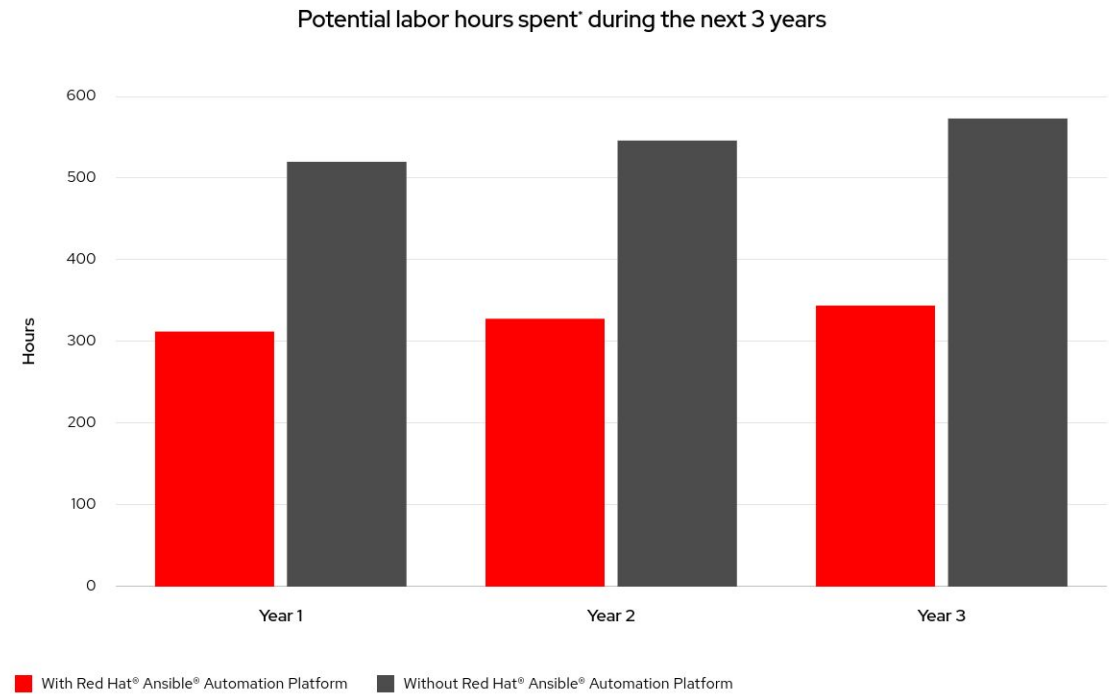

On top of this, you must also be familiar with Kubernetes internals, such as the API and how events are generated for resources.
