- Early 2018, Red Hat acquired CoreOS
- CoreOS company had 3<sup>rd</sup> largest Kubernetes commits
- CoreOS Products
  - CoreOS (container OS)
  - Tectonic
  - Quay
- Future state:
  - Tectonic to merge into OpenShift – better for operators
  - Atomic and CoreOS to merge – better update process
  - Quay, stay as product
