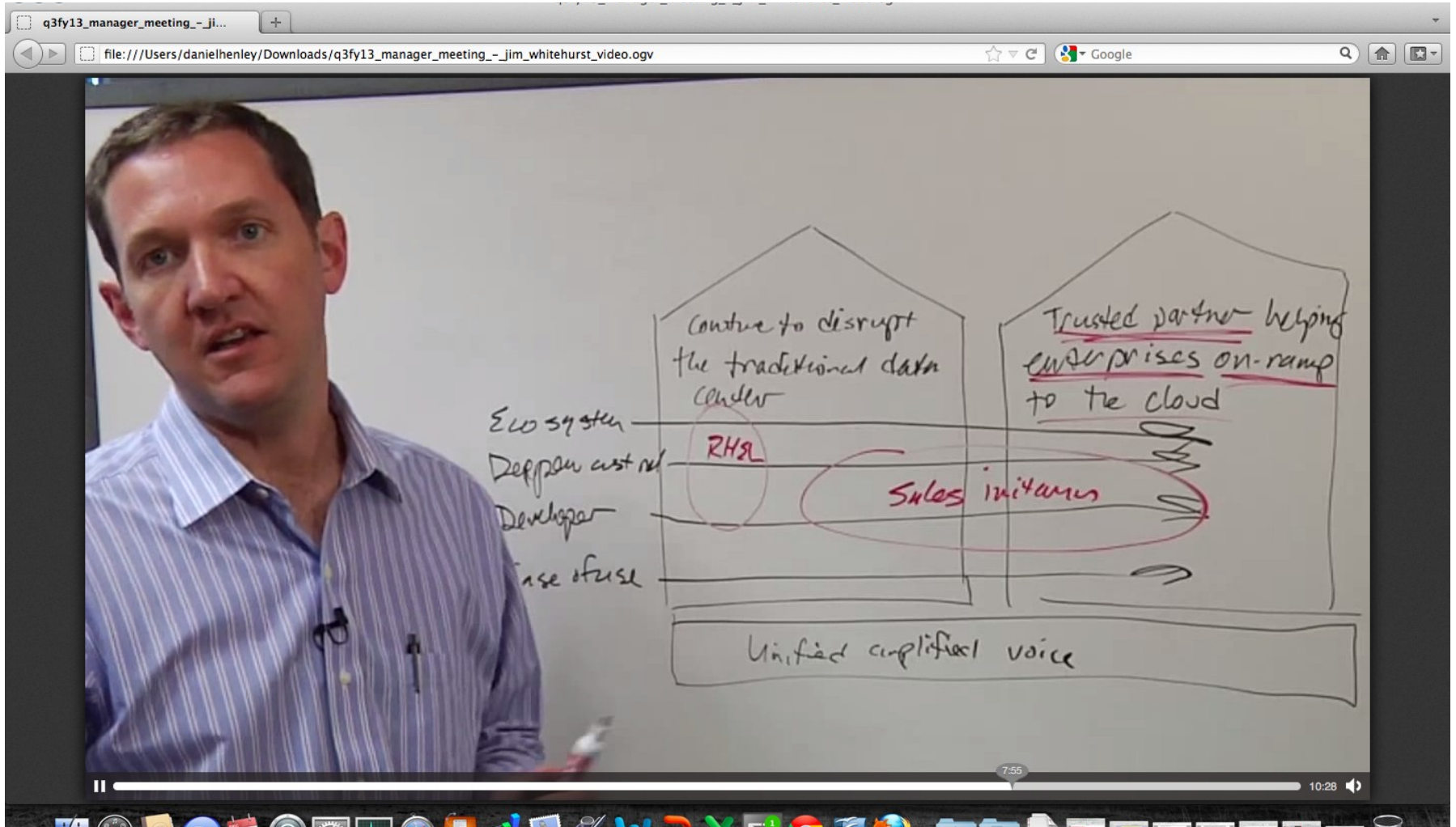

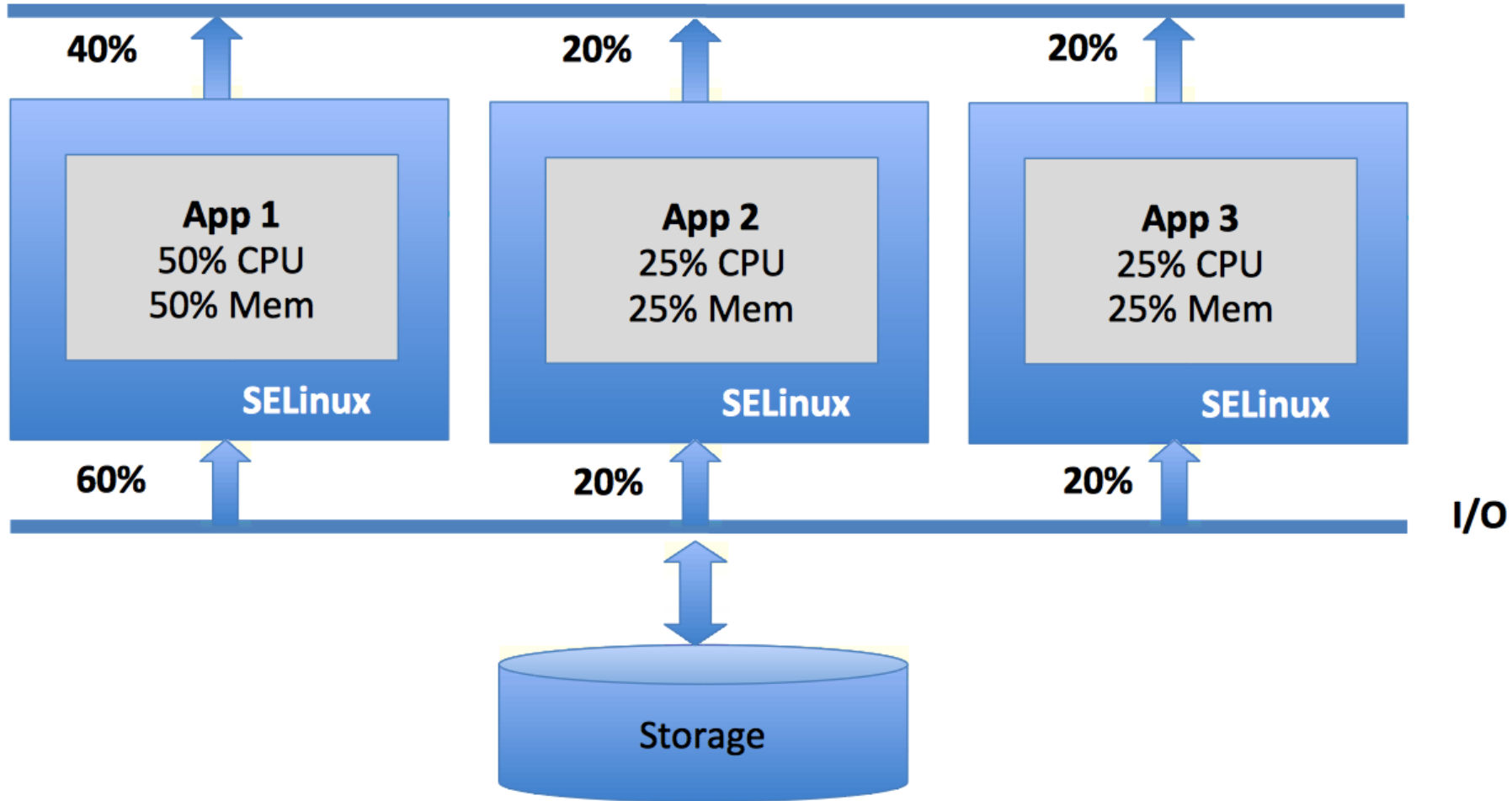

LINUX POWERS 80% OF THE WORLD'S LARGEST CLOUDS

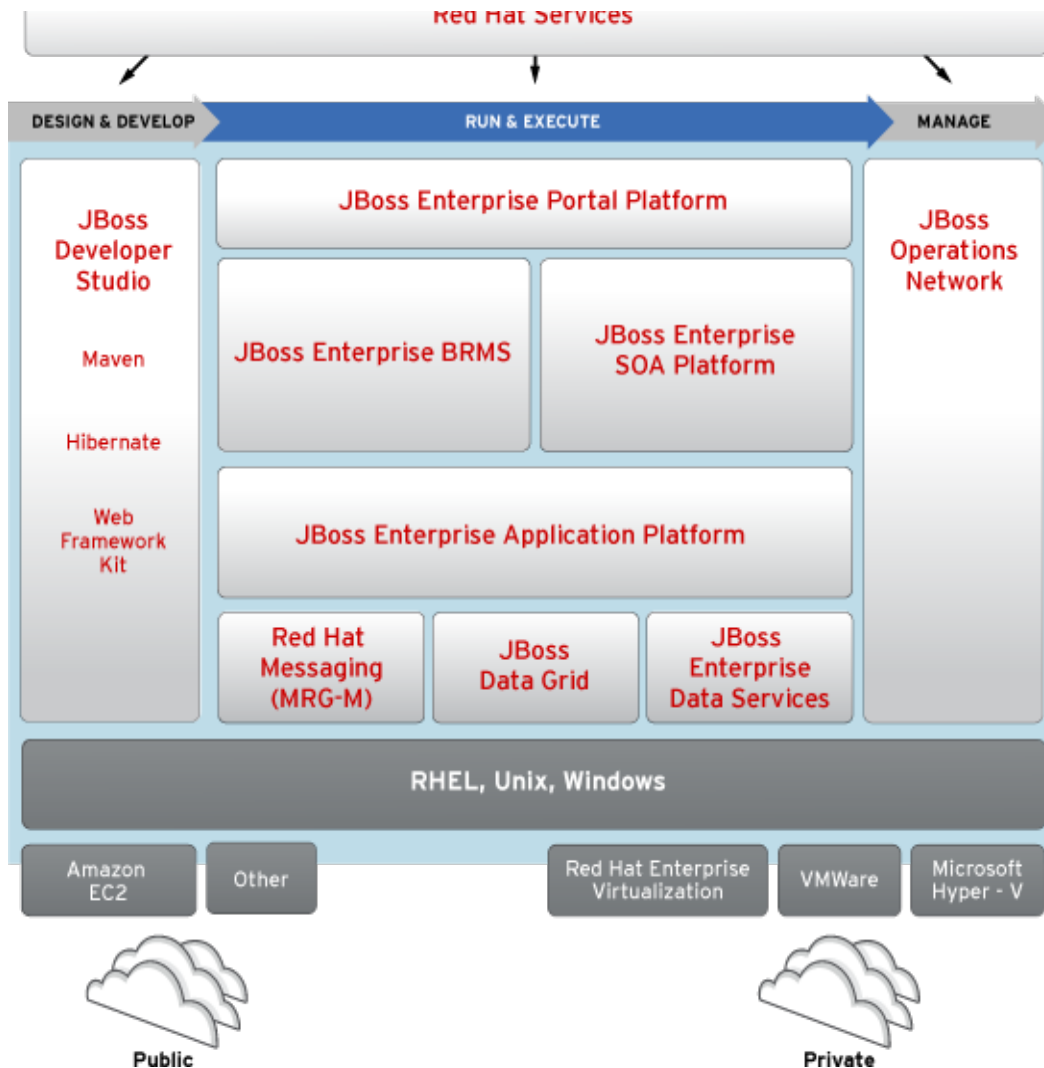
- Enables secure, dense, multi-tenancy with QOS
- Delivers scalable, reliable run time for business critical applications





- JBoss is More Important Than Ever!!!!
  - Middleware Users Tend to Be Application Focused
  - Middleware Users Tend to Be Building Capital Intensive Applications – they're not keeping the lights on....their creating the future!!
  - Middleware Users Tend to be Solving Complex Business Problems
  - Adopting Compute as a Service (Software, Platform, Infrastructure) requires a Service based, flexible Application Architecture
