# CVE-2019-5736 – Important!

- A vulnerability discovered in runc allows for a break out from the container to gain root-level access on the host machine.
- Affects both packages: docker and runc
- SELINUX mitigates!
  - Red Hat Enterprise 7.x
  - Red Hat OpenShift Container Platform 3.x
  - Red Hat OpenShift Online
  - Red Hat OpenShift Dedicated
