  - Satellite 5.6 and 5.7 supported until March 31, 2017



# RHEL 6.7 features

- New resource agents enable Pacemaker HA support for nginx and SAP HANA.
- *scap-workbench* simplifies the creation of profiles, plus the scanning and remediation of systems
- Many SSSD improvements
- Full support for OpenJDK 8
- KVM hypervisor now support 240 vCPUs per VM
- Kdump supports hugepage filtering, and can be configured to be ignored during kdump



# RHEL 7.1 features

- Allocation of 1GB hugepages per node \* Sandy Bridge and newer
- Ceph RBD driver now supported and included in RHEL 7.x
- LVM Cache logical volumes via dm-cache
- GFS2 max file system size increased from 100TB to 250TB
- Tools to convert RGManager based cluster configuration files to PaceMaker format
- FIPS-140 Re-validation
- New features in OpenLMI – thin provisioning, SCSI re-scan and discovery, VG modifications
- New real time kernel included in RHEL 7.x for deterministic workloads

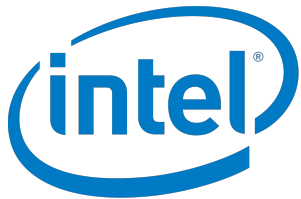
